Future Rate of Change of Frequency (RoCoF) Protection Settings

We first wrote to you in January 2013 with an open letter ¹ highlighting the potential for a change to the requirements for Loss of Mains (LoM) protection settings. The letter informed of a number of matters under discussion including likely ranges of RoCoF, how any decision to change requirements would be made and how protection setting changes would be implemented.

We {the Distribution Network Operators} also wrote to you directly, to seek your assistance to help assess the resilience of the Great Britain (GB) electricity supply system by reviewing the settings on the Loss of Mains protection applied to your generating plant. The letter noted that at a later date protection setting changes may be required.

The joint Distribution Code and Grid Code Workgroup, Frequency Changes during Large System Disturbances, undertook to develop proposals for protection setting changes. Papers and details of the Workgroup meetings can be found on the National Grid Website².

The Workgroup have since developed a first set of proposals for change and have commenced a formal Industry Consultation. In summary, the Workgroup recommends that the minimum Rate of Change of Frequency setting specified for Loss of Mains protection on distributed generation within stations of registered capacity of 5MW and above should be changed to 1Hzs⁻¹ measured over 500ms. The change will be implemented by amending the Distribution Code and Engineering Recommendation G59.
