## **CUSC Amendment Proposal Form**

#### Title of Amendment Proposal:

Connection Application Form- Alternative Connection Offers in England & Wales and Scotland

#### Description of the Proposed Amendment (mandatory by proposer):

It is proposed to amend the CUSC Application Form for Bilateral Connection Agreements, (CUSC Exhibit B) to include additional questions to ascertain whether an Applicant has or intends to make an alternative application for connection in England & Wales or Scotland (or vice versa) to enable National Grid to ensure disclosure of information within National Grid is managed in accordance with National Grid Licence Special Condition M.

An alternative connection application is when an Applicant applies for multiple connections to the GB transmission system at different locations and at least one location is outside National Grid's Transmission area i.e. Scotland and where the Applicant does not intend to connect at all the locations which they have applied for, but intends to connect at a location which is most beneficial for their project. Please note this does not apply to competing offers between the Scottish TO's, as no advantage can be gained by National Grid and the normal procedures for confidentiality shall apply.

The proposer requests and recommends that this Amendment Proposal proceeds straight to Industry Consultation for a period of 2 weeks as we believe that it would be beneficial to make this change in a timely way.

**Description of Issue or Defect that Proposed Amendment seeks to Address** (mandatory by proposer):

National Grid under Licence Condition C8 is required to offer terms of Connection to the GB transmission system and co-operate and co-ordinate with the Scottish TO's in accordance with the STC when an application is within Scotland.

Special Condition M places a restriction on the use of certain information by National Grid within National Grid. National Grid is required to prevent information concerning alternative applications from being disclosed to employees that are responsible for or are involved in the preparation of such "competing" offers to ensure that National Grid does not share commercially sensitive information internally which could potentially be used by National Grid TO business to obtain some form of advantage over the Scottish TO.

However, at present there is no formal means for National Grid to identify within a Bilateral Connection Agreement (BCA) Application Form where an Applicant is making alternative application between England & Wales and Scotland.

It is therefore proposed that the CUSC Application Form for a BCA within Exhibit B is amended to request information about alternative applications from the Applicant.

National Grid believes that amending the CUSC Application Form to ensure that National Grid can ascertain whether an application is an alternative applications would better achieve applicable CUSC objective(a) – (*The efficient discharge by the licensee of the obligations imposed upon it under the Act and by the Transmission Licence*) by providing National Grid with the ability to determine whether or not it would be necessary to invoke the procedure required to prevent the disclosure of confidential information and to ensure compliance with Licence Special Condition M.

The Panel can reverse the Panel Secretary's decision and if this happens the Panel Secretary will inform the Proposer.
