



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources	Today: Heavy and slow-moving showers across Scotland, with bands of rain also affecting Northern Ireland, northwest England and parts of Wales. Sunny spells and well scattered showers elsewhere, but it will be very windy in the south, with gales in places. Tonight: Mostly dry in the south with winds slowly easing. Further north, showers, occasionally heavy, will continue, with some mist and low cloud developing on windward coasts and hills.
