



It will be often heavy and accompanied by strong winds. Northern Ireland and Scotland will become brighter, but with some heavy showers possible. Tonight: There will be further showers in the northwest, with the risk of thunder. Rain will clear central and southern areas overnight, but there will be scattered showers in the west.
