## Key areas of discussion

- What information would be required from the Transmission Owners to be able to progress
  with the modification including what questions would we want to ask of them, whether they
  would become workgroup members and how their methodology currently works for
  calculating the expansion constant. Next steps include the Code Administrator facilitating a
  call with the Proposer, the TOs and those interested to discuss the impact on the TOs and
  the Workgroup questions.
- Electricity Transmission Costing study summary produced by the Proposer including whether the Workgroup should be assessing previous studies or being more forward looking due to how much the system has changed and continues to change.
- The ESO actions including how easy it would be to update the Transport Model, what costs
  they receive already and whether they have any generic substation costs

## Actions from this workgroup meeting (all added to action log)

- 1. Code Administrator to circulate questions that the Workgroup discussed to ask the Transmission Owners
- 2. Code Administrator to look into CATO work and feedback on where the ESO is currently in terms of process that will be in place is it with Ofgem/what work is being done?
- 3. Code Administrator to circulate documentation that is relevant from workgroup members as discussed; SQSS Connection design document and promotion for renewable generation installation (island or outermost regions) in the renewed Renewables Energy Directive from 2018 in Article 4 (7).
