# **Headline Report**

# 1) Minutes of Previous Meeting

# 2) New Amendment Proposals - CAPs104 - 105

# CAP104 – Amendments to System to Generator Intertrip related terms concurrently defined in the Grid Code and the CUSC

CAP104 was submitted by National Grid. Emma Carr gave the Panel a presentation on the Amendment Proposal.

The Panel AGREED that CAP104 should proceed straight to Consultation for a period of one month.

#### **CAP105 – Change of Company Name for National Grid Company plc (NGC)**

CAP105 was submitted by National Grid. Emma Carr gave the Panel a presentation on the Amendment Proposal.

The Panel AGREED that CAP105 should proceed straight to Consultation for a period of one month.

Ben Graff gave the Panel a presentation on CAP089/090/91 Working Group Report.

The Panel AGREED: that CAP089/090/091 should proceed to Consultation for a period of one month.

#### CAP092 & 094 Working Group

Malcolm Taylor gave the Panel a verbal report on CAP092 and CAP094 Working Group.

The Panel NOTED the progress with CAP092 and that there was no interaction with CAP094. The Panel AGREED that the Working Group Report should be presented to the September Panel meeting.

The Panel NOTED the progress to date with CAP094 and that currently thirteen Alternative Amendments had been identified. The Panel AGREED to an EXTENSION of the working group consideration of one month so that the Working Group Report would be presented to the September Panel meeting.

Ben Graff gave the Panel a verbal report on CAP098/099. The Panel NOTED the progress. - The Panel AGREED that CAP097 Terms of Reference should be amended to include Mark Manley (Centrica) and Andy Truswell (National Grid) as working group members.

#### **Governance Standing Group Report**

CAP100 - Revision of CUSC Amendment Provisions to ensure that Amendment Reports contain a collective CUSC Panel Recommendation.

CAP101 - Removal of the Amendments Panel Chairman's Casting Vote – In context of Amendments Panel Recommendation vote.

CAP102 - Revision of CUSC Amendment Provisions to allow a Proposer to state whether they believe their Amendment has a security of supply dimension which means in the view of the Proposer it should be excluded from the Appeals Mechanism by the Authority

# **Headline Report**

The Panel AGREED that CAP100 and CAP101 should be MERGED so that one report and one set of legal text would be considered along with one Alternative Amendment.

The working group had considered CAP102 and agreed that there was no CUSC defect to amend. The Panel AGREED that CAP102 should be WITHDRAWN.

The Panel NOTED progress with CAP103 and NOTED that the Working Group Report would be presented at the September Panel meeting.

#### **Balancing Services Standing Group**

John Greasley provided the Panel with a written update on progress by the BSSG. The PANEL noted the progress since the last meeting,

#### **Consultation Papers**

CAP096 - Revisions resulting from Interconnector Separation - Consultation Paper

The Panel AGREED that CAP096 should be WITHDRAWN.

# **Authority Decision**

The Authority Decision associated with CAP086 – Proposal for earlier consideration of implementation dates. The decision has resulted in procedural issue when the Panel is required to make a decision if disparity occurs between proposed implementation dates. Emma Carr described 4 alternative approaches.

The Panel AGREED that the preferred approach would be a decision following e-mail discussion with a back up of a tele-conference discussion, as appropriate.

The Panel AGREED that implementation dates should be included as an issue in working group Terms of Reference.
