Defect & Proposal

- ◆ A number of Housekeeping Amendments required within the CUSC:
 - ◆ CAP108 – Correction of a reference within the definitions of Actual Amount and Notional Amount
 - ◆ CAP109 – Correction of a spelling mistake within the definition of Qualified Company
 - ◆ CAP110 - Government department name change. HM Customs and Excise has change to HM Revenue and Customs
 - ◆ CAP111 - Change of contact details in Application forms within the CUSC Exhibits
 - ◆ CAP112 – Correction of a reference within the definition Housekeeping Amendment

Facilitation of CUSC Objectives

- ◆ This will better facilitate CUSC objective (a)(The efficient discharge by National Grid of the obligations imposed on it by the Act and the Transmission Licence), by....
- ◆ CAP108 - Accurately referring to the correct clauses within the CUSC
- ◆ CAP109 - Correcting a spelling error
- ◆ CAP110 - Correcting identifying HM Revenue and Customs
- ◆ CAP111 - Accurately referencing the correct person for Application Forms
- ◆ CAP112 - Accurately referring to the correct clauses within the CUSC

Recommendation and Panel Decision

- ◆ National Grid requests CAP108 –112 are treated as Housekeeping Amendments and the timetable and procedure within CUSC 8.21.2.2 is followed.
