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Key areas of discussion

The Workgroup discussed the following:

- Since the previous workgroup meeting, the workgroup was asked to look into business rules for the various modular solutions which had been discussed in prior meetings. The workgroup stepped through draft business rules from the proposer for the original solution. Business rules will also be developed for any potential alternative solutions in due course.
- The issue of defining generator only spurs was also a key point of the meeting. Two potential definitions were developed in addition to the original proposal. At a high level, these three definitions include:
 - i) All local circuits and local substations
 - ii) Local circuit and local substations required only by a single generator
 - iii) Local circuit and local substations required only by a single generator, at their time of connection

These three definitions will be continued to be developed throughout the workgroup process.

- The potential impact on TNUoS tariffs was also discussed. The ESO will consider what analysis can be incorporated in the workgroup consultation.
- Following the workgroup, the workgroup consultation was circulated for review ahead of publication.
