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Key areas of discussion

The workgroup discussed the following:

 The Proposer presented <u>slides</u> to the workgroup, which included the Proposer's current draft solution:

The proposed draft solution will allow users to use the new Transmission Outages Generator Availability (TOGA) platform to make submissions along with Regulation on Wholesale Energy Markets Integrity and Transparency (REMIT) submissions through the ELEXON REMIT portal. The new platform will accept data at the same frequency and format as REMIT submissions.

- The Proposer clarified that the choice of platform to submit data would be at a unit level
 rather than organisational level. This would allow industry to submit data using a blend of
 the platforms (TOGA or REMIT or both) if required, therefore providing maximum flexibility
 to industry when submitting data to National Grid Electricity System Operator (NGESO) to
 meet its obligations.
- The workgroup expressed support for the Proposer's draft solution as it deals with the concerns previously raised by the workgroup and there are tangible benefits for industry.

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- The workgroup discussed multi shaft submissions. The workgroup acknowledged that depending upon the final solution, multi shaft data may have to be submitted twice. It was agreed that the workgroup consultation should look to seek feedback on this issue.
- ELEXON confirmed that a Balancing and Settlement Code (BSC) change would be required but based on the current proposal it is anticipated that this would be a small modification. In addition, there would be an IT impact as there would be some system changes required.

Next steps

The workgroup agreed that the workgroup consultation should be finalised and issued during week commencing 2 December 2019.

The next workgroup will take place on 14 January 2020 to discuss workgroup consultation responses.
