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Key areas of discussion

- National Grid ESO provided further analysis on Nodal Tariffs, the use of DNO zones as a solution, the use of ETYS zones and analysis on increasing the £1/kW range to £2.25.
- The workgroup decided that they would not continue to develop any alternate solutions based on using ETYS zones, however there is interest within the workgroup at raising an alternate to the original CMP324 solution using an increased range based on RPI.
- The workgroup reviewed the draft consultation document and agreed the main structure
 of the report. The workgroup will have until midday on 24 February 2020 to provide
 further comments on the document. It is planned that the consultation will open next
 week for industry comment.

The next Workgroup will be arranged after the consultation period.
