
RFI: Summary of Responses

- Remain committed to Q2 2020 announcement on tender, but this is subject to the current climate and no significant delays
- Internal work:
 - Detailed studies on stability, voltage and thermal constraints to support business case
 - Working alongside Stability and Voltage Pathfinder to ensure products are cohesive
 - Aligning internal working with NOA Commercial Solutions
 - Closer collaboration with TOs and DNOs to greater understand the communication links possible

The RFI has allowed us to identify significant opportunity but now multiple hurdles need to be tackled to prove the benefit to the end consumer before a tender can be announced.
