## Key areas of discussion

The Workgroup discussed the following:

- In the previous, it was highlighted that there were potential interactions with P396, a BSC modification. The workgroup discussed this further, with Ofgem highlighting that in their opinion, BSC charges do not interact with the limiting regulation. The workgroup requested that Ofgem's legal team provide rationale behind this and if BSUoS charges are to be included in the calculation
- The workgroup will await clarification on the rationale before deciding if further alternatives are to be raised.
- The ESO presented legal text for the original solutions. This will be reviewed by the workgroup members ahead of the next meeting.
- The workgroup also reviewed the terms of reference for CMP339, a modification consequential of CMP317 & CMP327.
- The Code Administrator will poll suitable dates in week commencing 6 April 2020 to hold the next workgroup.
