

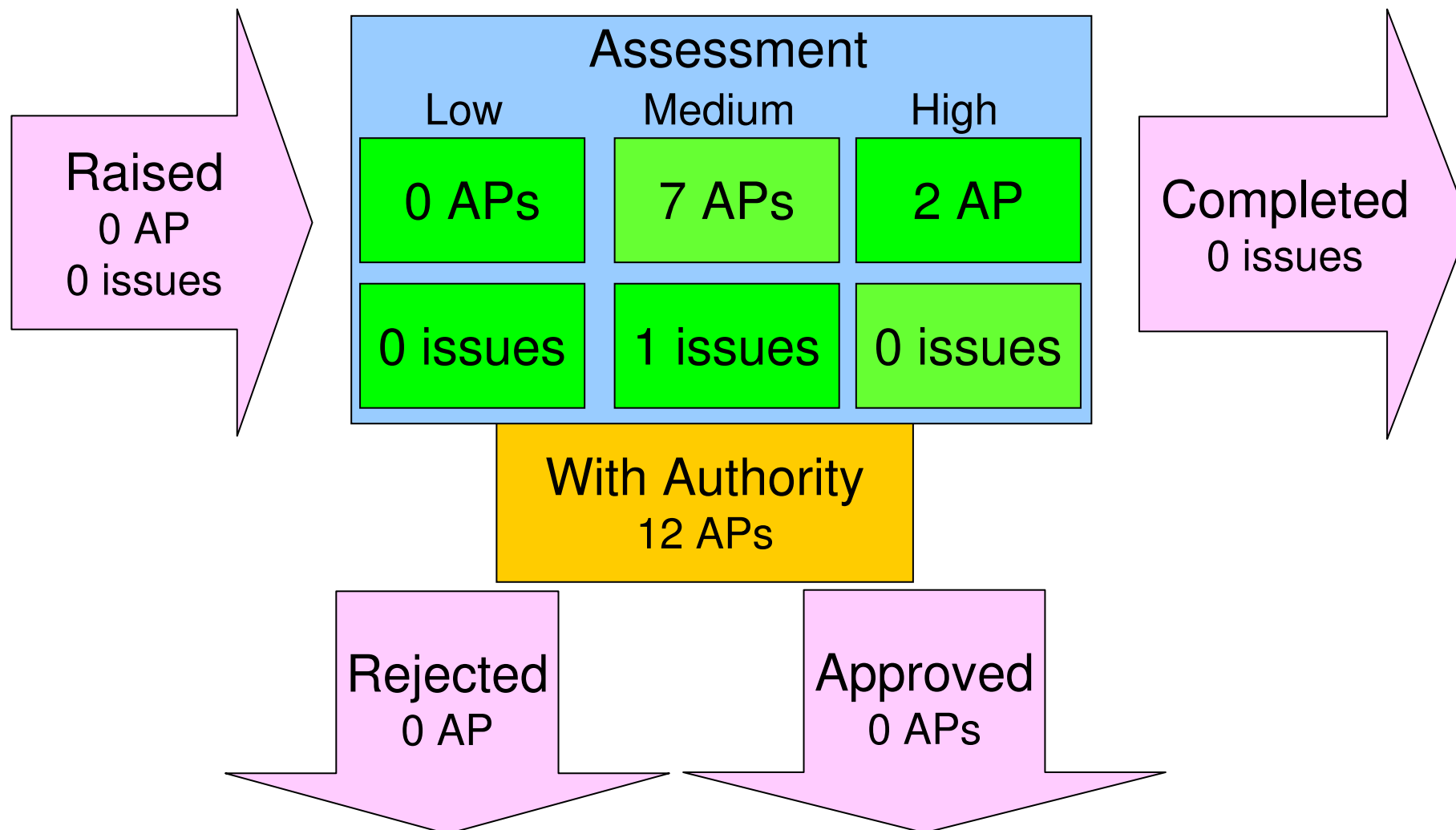
CUSC Key Performance Indicators September 2010



Introduction

- CUSC KPIs were introduced in October 2009
- The KPIs cover two areas:
 - Amendments KPIs – to monitor progression of proposals through the amendments process
 - Amendments Panel KPIs – to measure performance of administration of the Panel
- The KPIs are reported to the Panel each month, on a retrospective basis

- Working group required

Amber	Number of APs taking longer than initial timescales agreed by Panel, but variation agreed by Panel Members	Panel rejects Working Group recommendation to move to Company consultation but not due to failure of analysis, Terms of Reference, process or presentation
Red	Number of APs taking longer than initial timescales agreed by Panel, with no agreed variation by Panel Members	Panel rejects Working Group recommendation to move to Company consultation due to failure of analysis, Terms of Reference, process or presentation
