Background

- 30th December 2010 Code Governance Review modifications implemented
- 12th October 2010 Extensive comments from Ofgem
 - Changes were non material
 - NGET would address post implementation
 - Letter of comfort to Ofgem



Proposed CUSC Modification

- Proposed changes to the following areas of Sections 8 & 11:
 - Significant Code Review
 - Self-governance
 - Governance of Charging Methodologies
 - Send Back
 - Environmental Assessment
 - Code Administrator Assistance
- Additional non-material housekeeping changes



Justification for Self-Governance

- Proposed changes are non-material
- Circulation of draft legal text for comment on 22nd February 2011:
 - GSG Minor comments
 - Ex Governance Working Group no comments
 - Ofgem Minor comments



Applicable CUSC Objectives

- a) Efficient discharge of Act and Licence obligations
 - Provides greater clarity to Sections 8 & 11 and allow a more efficient operation of the modification procedures

- b) Facilitating effective competition
 - Provides clarity on governance procedures which helps smaller industry participants in raising potential modifications to the CUSC



Recommendation to the Panel

- The Panel is asked to agree that:
 - The proposal meets the Self-governance criteria
 - The proposal proceeds to the GSG for further review of the text
