



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: A mostly dry day but areas of freezing fog and low cloud will be slow to clear, and may persist for some places, especially parts of eastern England. Elsewhere some sunshine but chilly nonetheless after a frost in places  Tonight: Starting dry and frosty, with fog patches possible in the east. Strong winds and rain reaching western areas by midnight, perhaps turning to snow in places as it pushes east.
