This note sets out the headlines and key decisions of the most recent meeting of the CUSC Modifications Panel under the CUSC constitution. Full minutes of the meeting will be produced and approved at the next meeting of the Panel and will then be published on the website.

1) Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on 6 May 2011 were APPROVED and will be published on the National Grid website shortly.

2) New CUSC Modification Proposals

CMP198 – Proposer Ownership of CUSC Modification Proposals. This proposal seeks to change the CUSC to allow the proposer to change their proposal up to the point of the Workgroup vote. The Panel AGREED for CMP198 to be progressed as a **Standard CUSC Modification Proposal** and to be sent to a Workgroup to report back to the August 2011 Panel.

3) Industry Code Updates

CAP189 – Standard Gas Insulated Switchgear Ownership Boundaries. The Panel accepted the Workgroup Report and AGREED for CAP189 to proceed to the Code Administrator Consultation for 3 weeks.

CMP192 – Enduring User Commitment. The Panel AGREED to a 1 month extension for CMP192 **subject to Authority agreement**, to allow for additional Workgroup meetings to take place.

4) Authority Decisions

5) CUSC Modifications Panel Vote

Self-governance vote:

CMP193 – Housekeeping modifications to Section 14 of the CUSC. The Panel voted to **APPROVE** CMP193 which will be implemented without the approval of the Authority, subject to the Self-governance appeals procedures.

CMP194 – Housekeeping modifications to Section 11 of the CUSC. The Panel voted to **APPROVE** CMP194 which will be implemented without the approval of the Authority, subject to the Self-governance appeals procedures.
