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## Dynamic Containment (DC) Terms and Conditions

Dear Industry and Colleagues,

In accordance with Article 18 of COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing (EBGL), National Grid ESO is required to consult on terms and conditions related to balancing.

This letter confirms that the updated terms and conditions for DC as consulted on between 17 December 2020 and 21 January 2021 have now been approved by Ofgem<sup>1</sup>.

Now approved, these terms form part of the Article 18 terms and conditions as envisaged in CUSC section 4, paragraph 4.2B.5 and as required in that paragraph for any subsequent amendments to the terms to follow an amendment process which is compliant with the EBGL amendment process requirements.

The new terms and conditions can be found on our website<sup>2</sup>, alongside tracked change versions<sup>3</sup>, updated supporting documents, a summary of consultation responses with ESO comments and a summary document of all changes made through the consultation process for transparency. The updated terms will be effective from 02 March 2021.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who took the time to respond to the consultation, your feedback is invaluable to help us to continue to evolve and develop the service through the Soft Launch.
