Background

- BSUoS charged 50 / 50 to generation & demand.
- Prevalent national arrangements within EU is to charge predominantly to demand.
 - France: G/D split 2% / 98%
 - Netherlands: G/D split 0% / 100%
 - Ireland SEM: G/D split 25% / 75%
- GB Market Price "uplifted" by BSUoS
 - Not comparable or competitive with other EU member states



Summary of Defect

In context of EU internal market in electricity, GB arrangements disadvantage GB generation when compared to equivalent generation in other EU Member States.



Proposed CUSC Modification

Remove BSUoS charges from GB generation.

Justification against Applicable CUSC Objectives



- Relevant objective (a): Facilitate effective competition.
 - Promotes level playing field between generation in EU internal market for electricity;
 - Hence facilitates further cross-border trading with benefits to both GB consumers and generation as a consequence.
- Relevant objective (c): transmission business developments.
 - Reflects National Grid's duties to promote EU internal market.
