1) Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes from the meeting held on 29th November 2013 were approved subject to minor changes and will be available on the National Grid website shortly.

2) New CUSC Modification Proposals

3) Workgroup Updates

CMP222 – User Commitment for Non-Generation Users. The Panel noted that the Workgroup Consultation had been published on 18th December 2013 and will close on 20th January 2014.

CMP223 – Arrangements for Relevant Distributed Generators under the Enduring Generation User Commitment. The Panel agreed to a 1 month extension to allow for comments on the draft Workgroup consultation to be reviewed further prior to publishing.

CMP224 – Cap on the Total TNUoS Target Revenue to be recovered from Generation Users. The Panel noted that the Workgroup Consultation had been published on 19th December 2013 and will close for comment on 23rd January 2014.

CMP225 – Consequential changes following implementation of the Third Package and other miscellaneous changes. The Panel noted that the like for like BSC Proposal P298 had been accepted by the BSC Panel at their meeting on 12th December 2013 and that the first joint Workgroup meeting would be held on 6th January 2014.
