CMP234 'Incorporation of Biddable Indexation of OFTO revenues in TNUoS'

Background

- Under Offshore Tender Rounds 1 & 2 (TR1 & TR2) OFTO allowed revenues are fully indexed by RPI on an annual basis.
- Ofgem have introduced the option for revenues to be partially indexed to inflation going forward.
- Bidders will be able to specify the proportion of revenue they wish to have linked to RPI.

Summary of Defect

- Local TNUoS tariffs are based upon the proportion of OFTO revenue associated with each asset.
- Under the existing arrangements these are inflated by RPI each year and reviewed at the start of each (onshore) price control period.
 - Assumes OFTO revenue is fully indexed by RPI.
- Partially delinking OFTO revenue from RPI, will result in associated local TNUoS tariffs increasing at a faster rate than the corresponding OFTO revenue



Proposed CUSC Modification

- This Proposal seeks to:
 - Modify the indexation of Local Offshore TNUoS tariffs to link to indexation in OFTO licence instead of RPI.
 - This Retains existing principle of linking Local Offshore TNUoS tariffs to OFTO revenue; and
 - Reflects changes to OFTO Licence conditions.
- Changes are proposed to paragraphs 14.15.63 (OFTO specific expansion factors) and 14.15.87 (Offshore substation tariffs).
 - Pre-CMP213 numbering.
 - Wording unaffected by CMP213.

Justification against Applicable CUSC Objectives

Ensures that local TNUoS charges for TR3 Offshore assets are equivlent to those under TR1 and TR3.

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- Better meeting applicable objective (a) Competition
- Maintains link between OFTO revenue and local TNUoS charges and hence cost reflectivity.
 - Better meeting applicable objective (b) Cost reflectivity
- Accounts for changes to OFTO licence terms, by reflecting the updated revenue calculation.
 - Better meeting applicable objective (c) Taking account of transmission business developments

Justification against Self Governance criteria

Aim of the proposal is to:

1. Simply reflect pre-approved OFTO Licence changes in the charging methodology.

Therefore is not considered a material change.

Indexation applied to charges will depend upon tender process.

- 2. Maintain the existing link between offshore local TNUoS charges and OFTO revenues.
 - Avoids potential discrimination between different offshore generators.
