High level plan for Day Ahead Capacity Calculation Technical Procedure

Timeframe	Day Ahead Capacity Calculation – What has been done so far
July 2021	EU TSOs requested time to develop a position. UK TSO workgroup continued with weekly workgroup to progress UK position and capacity calculation optioneering.
August 2021	NGESO shared optioneering with UK and EU TSOs for review. EU TSOs came back to the table on 27 th August with a high level update. UK TSOs continue to progress UK position and capacity calculation optioneering.
Early September 2021	Discussed the link between MLRVC and Capacity Calculation. Discussion on the approach to November 2021 deadline. Raised the risk to timeline with BEIS, further work required to share with BEIS & Ofgem.

Timeframe	Day Ahead Capacity Calculation – Next Steps
September 2021	Next meeting with EU TSOs will take place on Friday 17 th September 2021. Bi-weekly meetings with EU TSOs on the Day Ahead Capacity Calculation Technical Procedure.
October 2021	<i>Industry consultation on the Day Ahead Capacity Calculation Technical Procedure followed by submission to the Regulatory Authorities as per the TCA*</i>
November 2021	<i>Technical Procedure, plan for other timescales and RA opinion submitted to Specialised Committee for opinion*</i>
April 2022	<i>Entry into operation of technical procedure*</i>

**These timelines have been shared with the UK TSO SteerCo on the Technical Procedures. Further work is being done in the UK to ensure all parties agree. EU TSOs also will need to come to table and agree these timelines.*
