This note sets out the headlines and key decisions of the most recent meeting of the CUSC Modifications Panel under the CUSC constitution. Full minutes of the meeting will be produced and approved at the next meeting of the Panel and will then be published on the website.

1) Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes from the meeting held on 29 January 2016 and the 2 Special CUSC Panel meetings held 18 January 2016 and 8 February 2016 were approved subject to changes and are available on the National Grid website.

2) New CUSC Modification Proposals – No new proposals this month

3) CUSC Modifications Panel Determination Vote

CMP257 'Enabling the electronic (email) issue of 'offers' to customers'

The Panel decided to delay the vote on CMP257 by another month. They have requested written clarification from the Proposer on the process around sending offers via electronic mail which falls outside of the CUSC. The Panel determination vote on CMP257 will be on the agenda for the CUSC Panel meeting on March 2016.

CMP258 'Rewording of the legal text to align the CUSC with the intentions of CMP235/6'

The Panel voted against the Applicable CUSC Objectives for CMP258 and agreed unanimously that it better facilitates Applicable CUSC Objective (a) and by majority better facilitates Applicable CUSC Objective (b) and therefore should be implemented.

CMP242 'Charging arrangements for interlinked offshore transmission solutions connecting to a single onshore substation'

The Authority approved that CMP242 WACM1 on the 10 February 2016 with a proposed implementation date of 24 February 2016. Since the publication of this decision, the Authority have consented that National Grid implement CMP242, CMP213 and CMP248 on the 1 April 2016 due to efficiencies in the reproduction of the appropriate sections of the CUSC.
