

CMP263 – ‘Housekeeping changes to CUSC Section 14 legal text as a result of the implementation of CMP213, CMP242 and CMP248 on 1st April 2016’

Background

- Modifications that are due for implementation into the Section 14 of the CUSC on **1st April 2016**:
 - **CMP213** - 'Project TransmiT TNUoS Developments'
 - **CMP242** – 'Charging arrangements for interlinked offshore transmission solutions connecting to a single onshore substation' (delayed to be as one package on 1st April 2016)
 - **CMP248** – 'Enabling capital contributions for transmission connection assets during commercial operation' (delayed to be as one package on 1st April 2016)
- Ofgem approved **CMP242** on 10TH Feb 2016 and requested that some housekeeping changes be raised by NGET

Summary of Defect

- Due to the time lapsed between the approval of CMP213 on the 25TH July 2014 and its implementation date of 1st April 2016 there have been a number of modifications approved and implemented into Section 14.
- Numbering and references require updating due to this throughout Section 14
- Additional typographic errors identified and also updated in Fast Track Report for CMP263 (CMP231 legal text errors)
- Errors in CMP242 legal text requiring housekeeping changes

Proposed CUSC Modification

- This Proposal seeks to amend;
 - CUSC Section 14 – Charging Methodology
- These are typographical changes and therefore have no material impact on Users (base used for CMP263 includes CMP213, CMP242 and CMP248 implemented into Section 14 and shows in track changes the amendments required to tidy up Section 14 once these are implemented)

Justification against Fast Track criteria

Fast Track criteria

Is properly a housekeeping modification required as a result of some error or factual change; including but not limited to:

- (a) Updating names or addresses listed in the CUSC;*
- (b) Correcting minor typographical errors*
- (c) Correcting formatting and consistency errors, such as paragraph numbers or*
- (d) Updating out of date references to other documents or paragraphs.*

CMP263 fits this criteria as the changes are all typographical changes and referencing updates

Code Administrator Proposed Progression

- The Panel is asked to agree:
 - Whether CMP263 should be implemented
 - What date should CMP263 be implemented (*Code Administrator recommends 1 working day later on 1st April 2016 after Appeal Window closes – 31st March 2016*)
