Timelines and next steps for the approach to costs for the multi-region loose volume coupling trading arrangements under the EU-UK TCA update provided by Catherine Contiguglia, OFGEM

Catherine Contiguglia gave JESG a verbal update on timelines and next steps for the approach to costs for the multi-region loose volume coupling trading arrangements under the EU-UK TCA:

- We have decided to delay our decision on development costs until there is more clarity on the technical procedures following the feedback from the workshop held with IC TSOs and PXs who responded to the MRLVC consultation in May 2021 and considering the progress of the MRLVC project to date
- We also plan to re-consult on our minded-to position on development costs and minded-to position on operational costs when the technical procedures are consulted upon.

- Following this, we will then make a decision on the treatment of development costs and publish an updated minded to position on operational costs.
- We would then intend to make a decision on operational costs if/when we get the powers to do so via legislation.
- Overall, we believe this approach will strike a good balance between providing certainty on development costs sooner rather than later whilst having more clarity on roles and responsibilities contained in the technical procedures.
