CMP279: Housekeeping modification to amend typographical errors in the CMP272 legal text.







CUSC Panel – 28 April 2017 Lurrentia Walker

Background/summary of changes

- CMP272 was raised to implement Code Governance Review Phase 3 license changes into the CUSC.
- The Authority approved CMP272 and this modification was implemented on 14 March 2017.
- In their decision letter, the Authority noted three typographical errors within the legal text and recommended these errors be rectified via a Housekeeping Modification.

Justification against Applicable CUSC Objectives

- The Proposer believes that this change will better facilitate relevant objectives;
- (a) 'the efficient discharge by the licensee of the obligations imposed upon it under the Act and by this license'
- (d) 'promoting efficiency in the implementation and administration of the CUSC arrangements'

Specifically efficiency in the implementation of the arrangements described in the CUSC, by allowing the CGR3 changes to function in the manner in which it was intended.

Urgency / Self Governance

- Workgroups: No
- Fast track Self Governance: Yes, with a 15 day appeals window

Self Governance criteria.

- The Proposer recommends that this Proposal follows the Fast Track Self-Governance Procedures as the changes meet the required criteria as the changes look to:
 - i) Correct minor typographical errors;
 - ii) Correct formatting and consistency errors, such as paragraph numbering, or;
- The Self-Governance criteria is met as the modification is unlikely to discriminate between different classes of CUSC Parties and is unlikely to have a material effect on:
 - Existing or future electricity customers;
 - Competition in the generation, distribution, or supply of electricity or any commercial activities connected with the generation, distribution or supply of electricity,
 - The operation of the National Electricity Transmission System
 - Matters relating to sustainable development, safety or security of supply, or the management of market or network emergencies
 - The CUSC's governance procedures or the CUSC's modification procedures

- The Panel is asked to agree:
 - That Fast Track Self-Governance procedures should apply; and
 - This Fast Track Proposal should be implemented subject to a 15 Working Days Appeal window.
