1	Do you believe that the GC0152 Original Proposal better facilitates the Applicable Objectives?	<i>GC0152 is a very minor change to ensure that the Grid Code modification process is aligned with the requirements set out in the European Emergency and Restoration Code, which is an area of post-Brexit retained European Law. The impact is simply to require a minimum 1 month consultation for changes to areas of the code that fall within the mapped terms and conditions for System Defence and System Restoration Service Providers. No other obligations are changed by this.</i> <i>By complying with relevant legislation this change is positive against objective (d).</i>
