Grid Code Consultation C/06 & Establishment of Control Telephony Electrical Standard

Formal STC Committee Response to Grid Code Review Panel

- 1. During the development of the governance for the introduction of British Electricity Trading and Transmission Arrangements (BETTA) the matter of Control Telephony requirements were considered.
- Following discussion between the designate GB System Operator and the affected TOs, the standards that existed up to BETTA go-live were determined as being adequate for implementation after the go-live date. The resulting STCP04-5 (Operational Telephony) was written and introduced into the STC to ensure the ongoing requirement for the provision of such facilities.
- 3. The STC Committee does not foresee the requirements for a change to the provision of the existing Operational Telephony Standards, as defined within STCP04-5 (Operational Telephony), unless any of the standards are outwith Good Industry Practice.
- 4. Further changes to align with the proposals detailed in Grid Code Consultation C/06 (Control Telephony Electrical Standard) and the associated establishment of a Control Telephony Electrical Standard for England and Wales, would be deemed to be unnecessary and if required would result in additional infrastructure expenditure not contained within existing TO regulatory allowances.
- 5. The above response is in line with the responses provided by the respective Transmission Owners' Grid Code Review Panel representatives.
