Action 7

- **Provide view as to whether or not a licence change may be required for the ESO**
- Chapter 3 of the ESO's licence (Transmission Revenue Restriction) contains an “adjustment term” – ADJt (special condition 3.6) which requires changing.
- The ESO's ADJ calculation was designed to adjust for forecasting corrections on ESO's allowance, and not forecasting corrections relating to TOs' allowance.
- Currently, there is an existing issue, as the ADJ is exposed to TO revenue forecasting corrections (for example, OFTO revenue corrections due to asset transfer date slip). This issue is not caused by CMP286/287.
- However, the issue will be exacerbated under the mod, and the impact will become substantial. Thus the licence has to be amended.
