What is the issue?

This modification is seeking to remove any gender specific references or terminology within the STC and make it Gender Neutral. A separate modification has also been raised in corelation to this for the STCPs'.

Why change?

These changes will have a positive impact, as they will remove any gender bias, inequality, and discrimination within the STC. They will also acknowledge diversity and convey respect to all people. As well as aligning the STC to similar changes which have already taken place within the CUSC¹ and Grid Code².

What is the proposer's solution?

The following changes will be required to the STC along with some other minor typographical and housekeeping amendments.

<u>Note</u> that following feedback on the CUSC modification CMP380 by the CUSC Panel on 26 November 2021. 'Chair' will be amended to 'Chairperson' to align the language with Standard Condition C14 1A(i) of the Transmission Licence.



What is the impact of this change?

Relevant Objective (a) efficient discharge of the obligations imposed upon transmission licensees by transmission licences and the Act (b) development, maintenance and operation of an efficient, economical and coordinated system of electricity transmission (c) facilitating effective competition in the generation and supply of electricity, and (so far as consistent therewith) facilitating such competition in the distribution of electricity


When will this change take place?

Implementation date

This modification will be implemented 5 working days after the appeals window closes on 1 July 2022, providing no objections have been raised.

25 May 2022.

No systems or processes will need to be amended as a result of this proposal.

Proposer's justification for governance route

Governance route: Self-Governance modification to proceed to Code Administrator Consultation

As this modification:

- Already has a fully developed solution, which will only be making minor administrative changes to the code. We considered Fast-Track Self-Governance but believe it is more appropriate to include provision for an industry consultation.
- It does not discriminate between different STC Parties and does not have a material effect on:
 - Existing or future electricity customers,
 - Competition in the generation, distribution, or supply of electricity or any commercial activities connected with the generation, distribution or supply of electricity,
 - The operation of the National Electricity Transmission System,
 - Matters relating to sustainable development, safety or security of supply, or the management of market or network emergencies,
 - The STC Panel's governance procedures or the STC Panel's modification procedures.
