Background

- September 2009 GCRP
 - Paper pp09/33
 - National Grid giving further consideration to whether provisions should be included in the Grid Code relating to the allocation of rights to emit harmonic pollution
 - National Grid to report back to the November GCRP



Current position

- GC references ER G5/4 for the management of harmonic emissions
- Headroom to emit allocated on a first come first served basis
- In some cases, users' investment decisions on mitigation cannot be taken at the most efficient time
- National Grid believes that a review of the processes used in analysing and allocating emissions is required
- ER G5/4 falls under the ownership of the ENA
- 2008 ENA Engineering Committee agreed to establish a permanent co-ordination committee to look at all issues relating to power quality
 - Power Quality Electro-magnetic Compatibility PQ/EMC
 - Not yet met



Recommendation

- National Grid believes that ENA governance structures should be used to review G5/4 within PQ/EMC
- GCRP is asked to:
 - Support the requirement for a review
 - Write to the ENA explaining this
 - Request that PQ/EMC is taken forward
