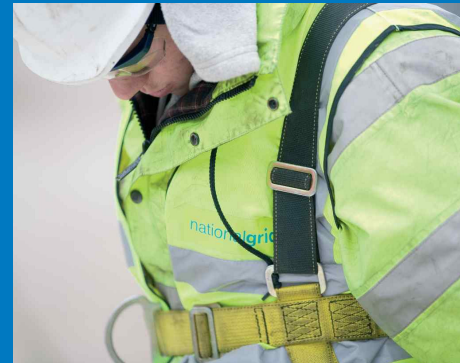

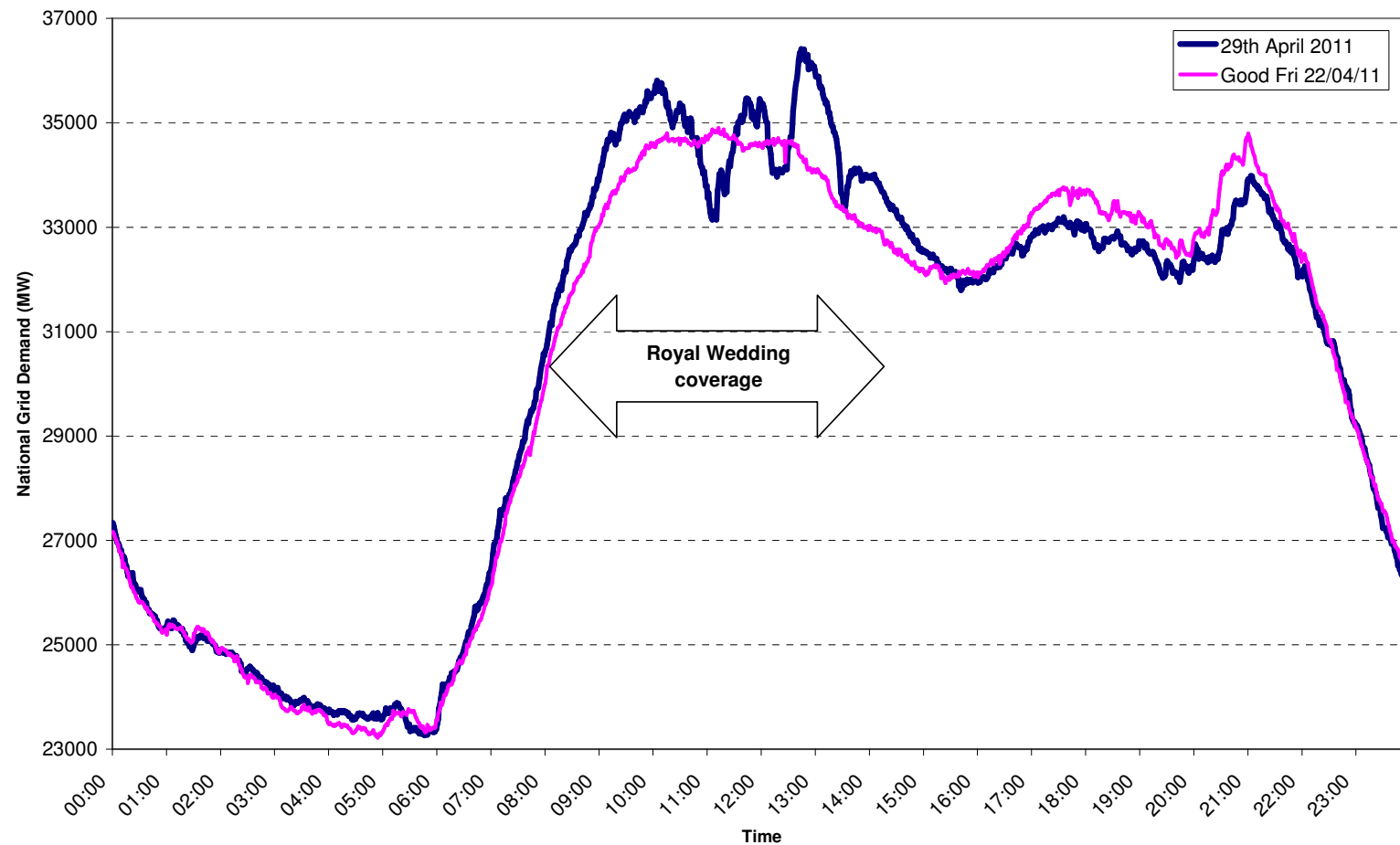
# Royal Wedding Planning

- Review of Transmission outages and asset health checks at key substations

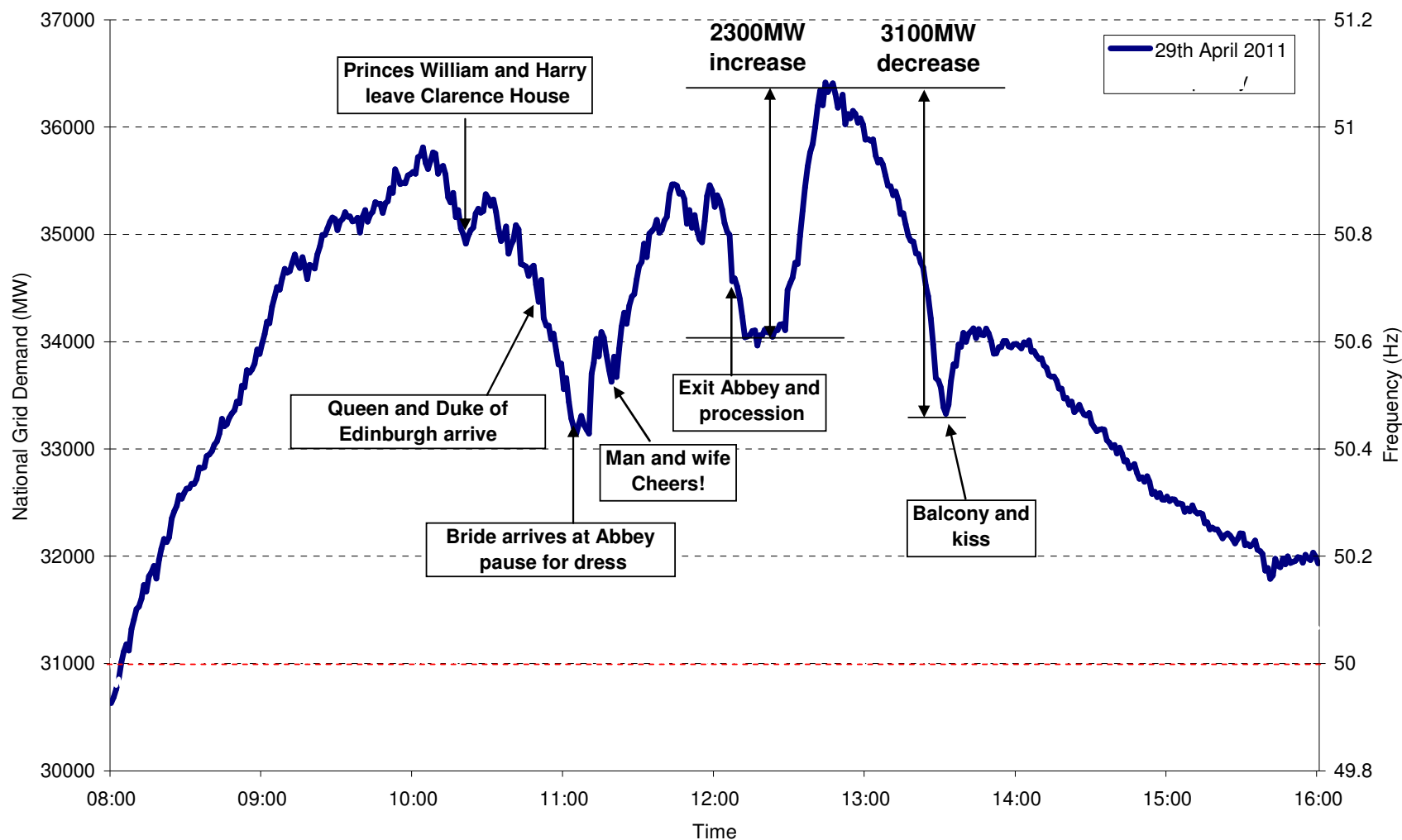

## ■ Overview of Electricity Demand



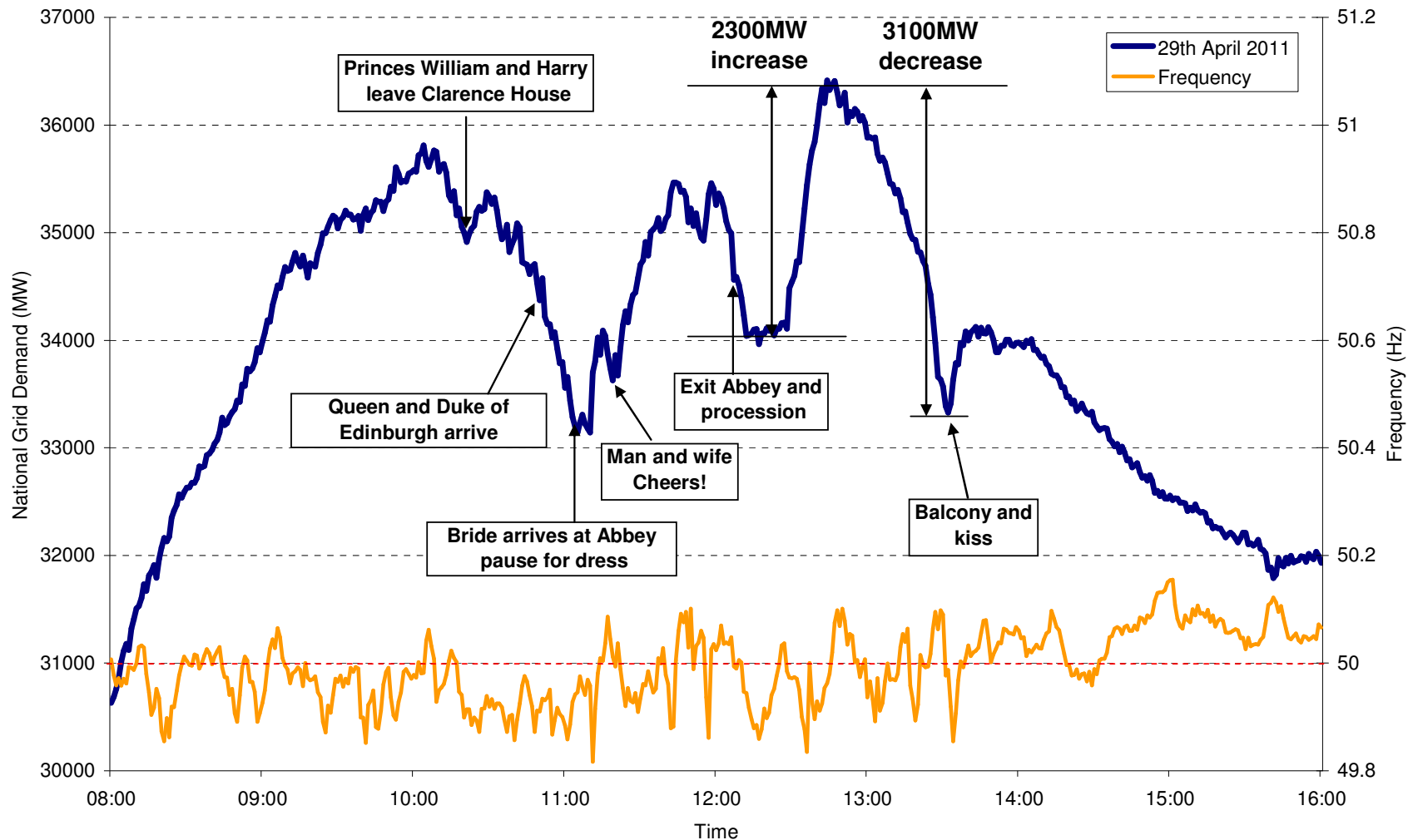
