Headline CGR2 proposals

CGR2 consultation will focus on industry codes, including Grid Code, that were not captured by the initial CGR proposals in 2010. The proposals will seek to:

- Introduce/increase self governance*
- Introduce Significant Code Reviews to all codes
- Require codes to observe the Principles of the Code Administration Code of Practice
- Require clear reasons to be given for recommendations to the Authority
- Enable Authority to 'send back' modification reports where a deficiency is identified (eg incorrect legal text)
- * At this stage we propose to consult on the Grid Code (and D Code) adopting an open governance framework, enabling users to formally raise modifications and giving more weight to the Panel's recommendation on change.

Timings and next steps

- CGR2 consultation published end Sept
- CGR2 workshop early Nov
- Consultation closes end Nov
- Conclusions and statutory consultation on licence modifications (as applicable) – early 2013
- Consequential code modifications made by mid 2013
