Key areas of discussion

• GC0154 seeks to provide clarity to stakeholders by incorporating Interconnector ramping requirements into the Grid Code in line with the requirements of SOGL A119.

- The purpose of this Workgroup was to narrow down the 10 solutions which have already been presented to the Workgroup.

- Also, the workgroup is keen to understand the view of the remote end TSO
