Reason for change (1)

- EBS Group:

- set up to develop and progress Grid Code changes related or derived from the commissioning of the EBS
- changes to Grid Code have already been delivered and there is no further changes in the pipeline
- EBS G has therefore no activity

- EBS IT Subgroup:

- set up to liaise with the industry about all IT aspects of the EBS, including interfaces EDL/EDT, EDL*/EDT*, associated tests and the Transition process BM to EBS
- EBS IT meets every 3 months, expected higher frequency when closer to Transition

Reason for change (2)

- EBS Multi-Shaft Modelling Subgroup:
 - set up to develop a model for CCGTs to be used by the EBS, expected to be implemented during the second phase of the project
 - due to the various delays on the EBS go-live date, the activity of this subgroup has decreased
 - EBS MSM subgroup is expected to pick-up activity once EBS is commissioned

Change proposal - Summary

- Extend scope of EBS IT:
 - to become an EBS stakeholder liaison group
 - includes current scope and industry business impact
 - excludes Grid Code changes

- Close EBS G until required for new GC changes
- Close EBS MSM until EBS is commissioned
