

Headline Report – 21 September 2022

Connection and Use of System Code (CUSC) Panel

The CUSC Panel Headline Report is produced after every Panel and aims to provide an overview of the key decisions made. Minutes for this meeting will be published separately.

Draft Final Modification Reports

The following Draft Final Modification Report was presented to the Panel:

CMP395 'Cap BSUoS costs and Defer payment to 2023/24 to protect GB customers'

CMP395 seeks to cap BSUoS per Settlement Period from 1 October 2022 to 31 March 2023, recoup the money in charging year 2023/24; and cap the liability to be carried by the ESO.

The CUSC Panel recommended by majority that the Original and all of the Workgroup Alternative CUSC Modifications better facilitated the CUSC Objectives than the Baseline (the arrangements currently set out in CUSC). The table below shows how many votes were in favour of the Proposed Solution being better than the Baseline.

Proposed Solution	Of the 8 votes, how many said that this option was better than the Baseline

WACM1	6
WACM2	6
WACM3	5
WACM4	7
WACM5	5

The Final Modification Report will be issued to Ofgem by the end of 21 September 2022. Ofgem advised at CUSC Panel that their decision would be on 29 September 2022 rather than 28 September 2022. For clarity, this means that the proposed Implementation Date is from the first Settlement Period (00:00 – 00:30) on 1 October 2022 if approved on 29 September 2022 (or such later date as Ofgem may specify).
