This note provides a summary of the main actions arising and agreements reached at the above Working Group meeting.

GSR 008 Fundamental Review	
Progress on the Fundamental review was discussed.	
 In Summary: WG 1 International Benchmarking. A GBSQSS workshop and International Benchmarking workshop was held in March. Final Benchmarking report is due to be completed by end of April. WG 2 Transmission entry workgroup is looking to develop a table which defines the appropriate connection requirements for different classifications of generation based on size. Will now discuss proposals with Hedd Roberts to ensure consistency with the CUSC. WG 3 The Main Interconnected Transmission System is reviewing the models for T+O+X and DTIM produced by SEDG. Existing scenarios are being modelled to allow comparison of required boundary capability figures with those identified as part of the GSR001 work. The Planning and Operational Contingency Workgroup is reviewing Fault statistics, voltage and stability criteria and their impact on transmission system boundary capabilities. The Offshore workgroup is further developing the cost benefit assessment model in order to assess the Round 3 windfarm proposals. 	СВ
The next milestone document (High Level Principles) is now planned to be issued at end of April. Andy Hiorns is discussing the detailed content of the fundamental review with Ofgem to ensure that the Fundamental Review does not delay any of the initiatives developed as part of the Transmission Access Review. Andy will advise the Review Group if there is any change to program or content.	АН
GSR 003 Review of design of generation connections	
The consultation document is in the process of being prepared. There was discussion over how the proposals would be affected by CAP 149. CB will arrange a meeting with Hedd Roberts to discuss the alignment of the proposals with Cap 149.	СВ

GSR 002 Housekeeping	
The final report has been prepared and is ready for submission to Ofgem.

During April it is anticipated that each of the TO's will be in a position to submit licence change requests to Ofgem.	JZH, CT, CB
Once this has been formally lodged and agreed with Ofgem then the Governance agreement can be formally signed off. It may be possible to do this at the next meeting of the GBSQSS Review Group in May.	
GSR 007 Review of infeed loss limits	
The consultation document was placed on the GBSQSS Review website in February. The consultation period has now ended. In total there were 8 responses to the consultation document.	
The review group will now respond formally to the responders to the consultation.	
A report on the consultation will be placed on the website in mid April.	ML
It is anticipated that a final review report will be provided to Ofgem by the end of June 2009.	
The review will require an impact assessment to be undertaken by Ofgem.	
It is anticipated that any changes to the GBSQSS proposed by the review could be implemented by the end of December 2009.
