Headline Report – 9 November 2022

Security and Quality of Supply Standards (SQSS) Panel

The SQSS Panel Headline Report is produced after every Panel and aims to provide an overview of the key decisions made. Minutes for this meeting will be published separately.

Approval of Panel Minutes

The meeting minutes from the Panel on 13 July 2022 were approved subject to minor comments from the Panel being incorporated and these will be uploaded to our website.

New Modifications

The following two new Modification Proposals were presented to the Panel:

GSR030: Offshore DC Connections

This modification aims to review the restrictions on the loss of power infeed risk allowed for outages of offshore DC converters.

The Panel unanimously agreed that GSR030 should proceed to a Workgroup. The Panel agreed the Terms of Reference for the Workgroup.

GSR031: Introducing Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners & Transmission Service Providers

This modification aims to introduce the concept of Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners (CATOs) to the SQSS to enable Onshore Network Competition for the design, build and ownership of Onshore Transmission assets.

The Panel unanimously agreed that GSR030 should proceed to a Workgroup. The Panel agreed the Terms of Reference for the Workgroup.

The Panel briefly discussed whether the modification required a Workgroup Consultation or whether one Workgroup meeting would suffice. The Panel agreed that it would be worth having a Workgroup Consultation to ensure those affected by the modification have the opportunity for their views to be considered. This is also in-line with the timelines for the related modifications to the CUSC, Grid Code and STC.

Decisions since last SQSS Panel

Modification	What this seeks to achieve	Decision
GSR028	To remove any gender specific references or terminology within the Security and Quality of Supply Standards (SQSS).	Approved. N.B. given the minor nature of the changes arising from GSR028, a draft version of the SQSS has been published on the NGESO website with a covering note explaining the changes within it. An updated version of the SQSS will incorporate these changes in due course. When an updated version is formalised, the Authority will hold a licence consultation to reflect the updated version of the SQSS in the Electricity Transmission Licence.

Awaiting Decisions

There are no SQSS Modifications awaiting a decision from Ofgem.
