



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Rain clearing from southeast, and any fog patches clearing from central areas by late morning. Then dry with sunny spells, although a few showers in the west, heavier and prolonged in the far northwest along with strong and gusty winds. Tonight: Clear spells in east allowing a patchy frost and perhaps a few fog patches. Windy elsewhere with showers in the northwest, heavy at times, spreading to other western parts later.
