Legal Text Changes

The amendments that have been made following Workgroup 1 are:

- 1.24 amended to expanded text and 1.25 added to address circumstance where a CATO connects to more than 1 incumbent TO with distinct, different standards
- The definition of Large, Medium & Small power stations definition has had CATO added to clarify that thresholds for power stations connected to a CATO will follow the current thresholds applied within the current incumbent TO transmission areas.
