Scottish TO's will implement new CPA's using current process

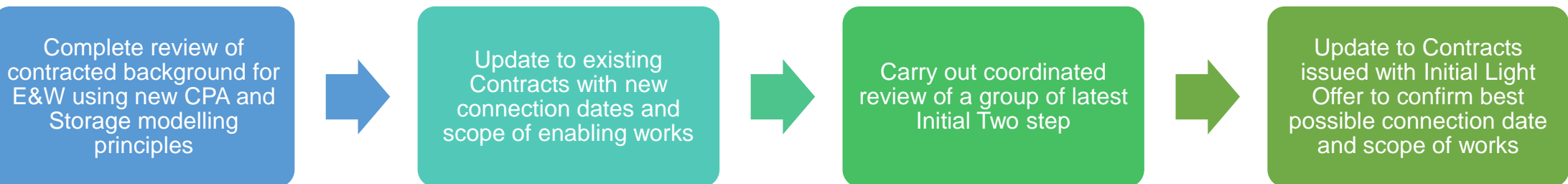
Still pending comfort from Ofgem

Why are we proposing a Temporary Two-Stage Offer Process

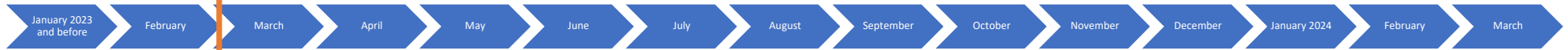


Processes to happen in parallel

Group 3

From the 1st March any Clock started applications will be subject to the Two Step process if applicable

These are indicative, detail wont be known until TRW studies are underway

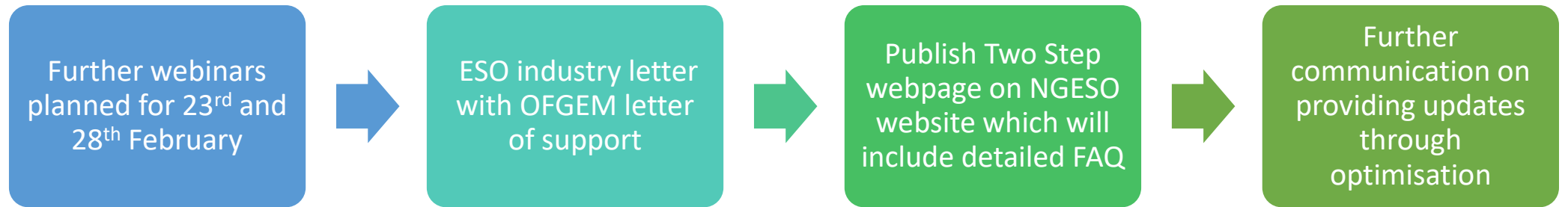
Application Types to be included in Two Step process
