## Key areas of discussion

The Workgroup discussions are summarised according to agenda items:

#### **Action Log Review**

The Workgroup agreed to close action 55 and 58. Workgroup agreed that actions 65 and 66 were to be discussed together with the Legal text review with the intent to be close by the end of the meeting.

### Review of Legal text

Workgroup review the Legal text live and the highlights were:

- 2.23.6 Workgroup agreed to remove this clause as it is duplicated in 2.23.4, however the Workgroup decided to keep point g) and d) and merge into the 2.23.4 clause.
- 2.23.4 Workgroup agreed to add clarification around the fact that when intervention occurs will only be for the assets impacted by the intervention criteria listed in the clause. Merged point e) and h).
- 2.24.3 Workgroup agreed to remove clause but moved last paragraph to 2.24.2.
- Workgroup discussed at length the scope around intervention and the financial consequences for the User. The Workgroup agreed in principle that the User shouldn't be penalised financially if an intervention occurs to no fault of their own.
  - However there were opposing views in the case of the User deciding to deviate from their contract and entering into pre-empting costs. The Proposer felt that these costs should be recoverable, whilst several Workgroup Members felt that the User should follow the contract set with the TO for the Contestable Work and that doing this was entirely to their own risk and that any deviation from the scope of the works should be communicated and agreed upon before any action should be taken. A Workgroup member also advised that by adding this scope to the Legal text we will be negatively impacting the end users. It was agreed that to find a resolution there will need to be further discussion.
