Alec

Recently you mentioned to me that, now STC Amendment CA016 Alternative has been approved, we need to discuss the impact of this on the STC Procedures.

We've had a think about it here at National Grid, and believe that it would probably be best to create a new STCP18-4 Request for a Statement of Works.

CA016 introduces a new Part 4 of Section D of the STC to describe the process for assessing a Request for a Statement of Works, and, if Works are required, the application would then progress as a Modification Application through the existing Part 2 of Section D. Our thinking is to mirror this structure in the STCPs, with the new 18-4 specifying the Request for a Statement of Works process. Where Works are required, and the User wishes to proceed, the process would then be progressed through the existing STCP18-1.

The attached flow chart sets out our initial view as to what would be included in 18-4 and how it would work. Any views or comments on this from anyone copied in on this e-mail would be very welcome.



If there is broad agreement with the overall concept (and, if not, please let me know), I would anticipate writing a first draft of 18-4 and then organising a meeting to go through it in detail. I hope this seems like a sensible way forward.
