## 6.1 COMMERCIAL ANCILLARY SERVICE – CONSTRAINT MANAGEMENT

6.1.1 The Generator agrees to provide the Commercial Ancillary Service of Constraint Management in accordance with the terms of this Clause 6.

#### General Definitions

- 6.1.2 For the purposes of this Sub-Clause 6.1:
  - (a) **"Bilateral Connection Agreement"** means the Bilateral Connection Agreement between the **Generator** and **National Grid** dated **[\_\_\_\_\_]**;
  - (b) "Constraint Management" means, as applicable, provision of any of the services as provided for under this Clause 6 including Capped Output (Sub-Clause Error! Reference source not found.), Minimum Output (Sub-Clause Error! Reference source not found.), Capped Output (Option) (Sub-Clause Error! Reference source not found.) and Minimum Output (Option) (Sub-Clause 6.2);
  - (c) "Contracted Unit(s)" means [ ] at the Generator's [ ] Power Station;
  - (d) **"Day"** means a calendar day;
  - (e) **"Extended Service Period"** means one or more **Settlement Periods** notified to the **Generator** by **National Grid** in accordance with Clause 6.1.6;
  - (f) **"Extended Service Period End Date"** has the meaning (if any) given elsewhere in this Clause 6;
  - (g) "Service Term" means the duration of the Service Period and all Extended Service Periods (if applicable); and
  - (h) **"Trading Day**" means the EFA trading days of Monday to Friday, commencing at 23.00 hours the **Day** before.

Unless the context otherwise requires, words and expressions used in this Clause 6.1 which are defined in the **Balancing and Settlement Code** or the **Grid Code** and not otherwise defined in this **Agreement** shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the **Balancing and Settlement Code** or the **Grid Code** (as the case may be).

#### Unavailability

6.1.3 The Generator shall provide Constraint Management from the Contracted Unit(s) during the Service Term unless prevented from doing so by an unforeseen problem that arises caused by safety or technical reasons (relating to personnel or plant), but not operational or commercial reasons. If the Generator is unable to provide Constraint Management from any Contracted Unit at any time during the Service Term due to an unforeseen problem caused by such safety or technical reasons, it shall notify National Grid, by facsimile in the appropriate form set out in Annex 1 hereto (with reasons), as soon as reasonably practicable, and the Generator shall subsequently notify National Grid in the same manner as soon as reasonably practicable upon becoming aware that availability of Constraint Management from that Contracted Unit is restored.

#### Physical Notifications

6.1.4 The **Generator** shall comply with the obligations in respect of each **Contracted Unit** as set out in **Grid Code BC** 2.5.1.

#### Monitoring and Metering

6.1.5 For the purposes of this Clause 6.1, Active Power Output from the Contracted Units shall be measured by Energy Metering Equipment in accordance with the Balancing and Settlement Code.

### Extended Service Periods

- 6.1.6 Subject to Sub-Clause 6.1.3, **National Grid** may require in respect of any one or more **Contracted Units** one or more **Extended Service Periods**, and will notify the **Generator** of any such **Extended Service Period** no later than 11:00 hours on the **Trading Day** immediately preceding the commencement of such **Extended Service Period**, provided always that:-
  - (a) any such **Extended Service Period** may only be notified where it ends no later than the **Extended Service Period End Date**; and
  - (b) such notification shall be by telephone and confirmed by email or facsimile where email is unavailable.

#### Reactive Power

6.1.7 The provision of **Constraint Management** by the **Generator** from a **Contracted Unit** in accordance with this Clause 6.1.7 shall be without prejudice to the **Generator**'s obligation to provide **Reactive Power** pursuant to Grid Code CC6.3.2 and in accordance with the **Mandatory Services Agreement** entered between the **Parties** dated [\_\_\_\_\_\_].]

### Publication of Data

- 6.1.8 Notwithstanding the provisions of [Clause 9 of the MASA/Clause [] of this Agreement], National Grid shall be permitted to publish and/or announce details of the Commercial Ancillary Service of Constraint Management provided by the Generator from any Contracted Unit pursuant to this Clause 6, and the Generator hereby consents to such disclosure by National Grid.
- 6.1.9 Prior to any publication and/or announcement by **National Grid** in accordance with Sub-Clause 6.1.8, **National Grid** shall give reasonable notice to the **Generator** of its intention to publicise any details pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.1.8 and the **Generator** shall be entitled to notify **National Grid** of any amendments it proposes to the format of the publication details within 5 working days of receiving the same from **National Grid**.
- 6.1.10 **National Grid** shall give reasonable consideration to any proposed amendments it receives from the **Generator** in accordance with Sub-Clause 6.1.9 but shall be under no obligation whatsoever to accept or implement any such amendments.

## [Additional Costs

6.1.11 Clause [10 of the MASA/Clause [] of this Agreement] shall not apply to this Clause 6.1.11 and the provision of Constraint Management.]

#### Payments

6.1.12 All payments to be made by **National Grid** to the **Generator** under this Clause 6.1.12 shall be made in accordance with [Clause 4 of the **MASA**/Clause [] of this **Agreement**].

#### Communication details

6.1.13 Any notice or other communication made by the **Parties** to each other under or in accordance with this Clause 6 shall be notified to the other using the following details as applicable, or such alternative details as may be notified in writing by one **Party** to the other for such purpose:

## 6.2 COMMERCIAL ANCILLARY SERVICE - MINIMUM OUTPUT (OPTION)

6.2.1 The Generator agrees to provide the Commercial Ancillary Service of Minimum Output (Option) in accordance with the terms of this Sub-Clause 6.2.

## Definitions

- 6.2.2 For the purposes of this Sub-Clause 6.2:
  - (a) **"Agreed Energy Increase**" means [ ]MW;
  - (b) **"Availability Fee**" means £[ ] per Settlement Period;
  - (c) **"Event of Default"** means any of the circumstances described in Sub-Clause 6.2.11;
  - (d) **"Extended Service Period Availability Fee**" means £[\_\_] per Settlement Period;
  - (e) **"Extended Service Period End Date**" means [];
  - (f) **"Extended Service Period Utilisation Fee**" means £[\_\_]/MWh;
  - (g) "Instructed Service Period" means one or more settlement periods during the Service Term in relation to which an Instruction is issued and which shall be a period of [ ] during the Service Term;
  - (h) **"Instruction"** means an instruction to utilise **Minimum Output (Option)** issued by **National Grid** pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.2.6;
  - (i) "Minimum MW Level" means in respect of any Contracted Unit, Active Power Output not less than the MW level specified by National Grid during an Instructed Service Period pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.2.6;
  - (j) "Minimum Output (Option)" means operation of Contracted Unit(s) at the Minimum MW Level in accordance with the requirements of this Sub-Clause 6.2;
  - (k) "Service Period" means the period between [ ] hours on [ ] and [ ] hours on [ ];
  - (I) "Suspension" means the period during which the Parties' rights and obligations under this Sub-Clause 6.2 are suspended as set out in Sub-Clauses 6.2.12 to 6.2.15; and
  - (m) "Utilisation Fee" and "UF" means £[ ]/MWh.

Term

6.2.3 The provisions of this Sub-Clause 6.2 shall apply for the duration of the **Service Term**.

#### Generator's obligations

- 6.2.4 Subject to Sub-Clause 6.1.3, the **Generator** shall, throughout the **Service Term**, make available for **Instruction** by **National Grid**, **Minimum Output (Option)** from the relevant **Contracted Unit(s)** throughout any one or more **Instructed Service Periods**.
- 6.2.5 Without prejudice to Sub-Clause 6.2.4, for the purposes of this Sub-Clause 6.2, **Minimum Output (Option)** shall be deemed to be unavailable in any **Settlement Period** in respect of all or part of which the declared **Maximum Export Limit** for the **Contracted Unit** is zero (including where the **Maximum Export Limit** is declared down in accordance with an

instruction made by **National Grid** pursuant to the **Bilateral Connection Agreement**) and/or the prevailing **Dynamic Parameters** submitted by the **Generator** with respect to the **Contracted Unit** are inconsistent with the provision of **Minimum Output (Option)** and performance of the **Generator**'s obligations hereunder.

#### Instruction by National Grid

- 6.2.6 At any time during the Service Term, National Grid may issue to the Generator an Instruction, which shall meet the requirements of Sub-Clause 6.2.7. For the avoidance of doubt, the Parties agree that any Instruction issued prior to the Service Term shall be valid and effective for Instructed Service Periods commencing on or after the start of the Service Term.
- 6.2.7 Each Instruction shall:-
  - (a) specify the **Instructed Service Period**, in compliance with the submitted **BM Unit Data**;
  - (b) specify the Minimum MW Level, in respect of the Contracted Unit throughout the Instructed Service Period requiring the Output specified in the Physical Notifications prevailing at the time of the Instruction to be increased by the Agreed Energy Increase; and
  - (c) be submitted by facsimile in the form specified in Annex 3, to be received by the Generator no later than 6 hours prior to the commencement of the Instructed Service Period and no earlier than 17:00 hours on the Trading Day which immediately precedes the complete Trading Day ending prior to commencement of the Instructed Service Period (such that, for illustrative purposes only, an Instruction would need to be received by 17.00 on a Thursday to be valid for an Instructed Service Period that commences during the following Saturday, Sunday or Monday).

#### Acknowledgement by the Generator

- 6.2.8 Upon receipt of an **Instruction**, the **Generator** shall:
  - (a) as soon as reasonably practicable (and in any event on the **Trading Day** on which the **Instruction** is received for **Instructions** received by 17.00 hours on the **Trading Day**,) acknowledge receipt by facsimile or email to National Grid in the form specified in Annex 3 hereto;
  - (b) on the Day in which the Instructed Service Period commences, re-submit in accordance with Grid Code BC 1, the Physical Notifications in respect of the Contracted Units during the Instructed Service Period specifying a profile of intended aggregate Active Power Output which shall not be less than the Minimum MW Level in each Settlement Period, and shall maintain such Physical Notifications to Gate Closure with respect to each such Settlement Period; and
  - (c) procure that with respect to such Contracted Unit for each Settlement Period during the Instructed Service Period the instantaneous values of Active Power Output, unless otherwise instructed by National Grid, shall not at any time during a Settlement Period be less than the Minimum MW Level.

#### Payment

- 6.2.9 In consideration of compliance by the **Generator** with all of its obligations in this Sub-Clause 6.2, **National Grid** shall, subject always to Sub-Clause 6.2.10, pay to the **Generator**:
  - (a) an Availability Fee for each Settlement Period comprised in the Service Period during which Minimum Output (Option) is made available by the

**Generator** (for the avoidance of doubt **National Grid** shall not be obliged to pay the **Availability Fee** in respect of any periods of unavailability of **Minimum Output (Option)** (whether or not due to an event or circumstance of **Force Majeure**) including without limitation any periods of unavailability the subject of notifications by the **Generator** pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.1.3 and any periods of deemed unavailability pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.2.5); and

- (b) a Utilisation Fee for each Settlement Period falling in an Instructed Service Period in a Service Period in respect of the Agreed Energy Increase; and
- (c) an Extended Service Period Availability Fee for each Settlement Period comprised in the Extended Service Period during which Minimum Output (Option) is made available by the Generator (for the avoidance of doubt National Grid shall not be obliged to pay the Extended Service Period Availability Fee in respect of any periods of unavailability of Minimum Output (Option) (for the avoidance of doubt whether or not due to an event or circumstance of Force Majeure) including without limitation any periods of unavailability the subject of notifications by the Generator pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.1.3 and any periods of deemed unavailability pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.2.5); and
- (d) an **Extended Service Period Utilisation Fee** for each **Settlement Period** falling in an **Instructed Service Period** in an **Extended Service Period** in respect of the **Agreed Energy Increase**.
- 6.2.10 No Availability Fee, Utilisation Fee, Extended Service Period Availability Fee or Extended Service Period Utilisation Fee shall be payable for any Settlement Period in an Instructed Service Period during all or part of which an Event of Default pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.2.11 has occurred or is ongoing.

#### Events of Default

- 6.2.11 For the purposes of this Sub-Clause 6.2, an **Event of Default** shall be deemed to have occurred in the following circumstances:
  - (a) where, except during ramping or to the extent complying with an instruction from National Grid to provide Frequency Response or a Bid-Offer Acceptance given by National Grid pursuant to Grid Code BC 2.7, the Active Power Output of the Contracted Unit at any time is less than the Minimum MW Level; or
  - (b) subject to Sub-Clause 6.2.11(a) where the **Generator** is in breach of any or all of its obligations in Sub-Clause 6.2.8(a), (b) and/or (c).

## Suspension

- 6.2.12 **National Grid** may suspend the provision of **Minimum Output (Option)** from the **Contracted Unit** pursuant to this Sub-Clause 6.2 ("**Suspension**") forthwith by notice in writing to the **Generator** in the following circumstances:-
  - (a) where an Event of Default has occurred in 3 or more Instructed Service Periods during any 30 day rolling period or in 9 or more Instructed Service Periods during the Service Term; or
  - (b) upon any period or periods of unavailability of Minimum Output (Option) (excluding any periods of unavailability the subject of notifications by the Generator pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.1.3, but including without limitation any periods of deemed unavailability pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.2.5) which exceed:-
    - (i) in aggregate 120 hours in any consecutive period of 30 **Days**, or

- (ii) a continuous period of 7 **Days**.
- 6.2.13 With effect from **National Grid**'s notice of **Suspension** pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.2.12, and until any subsequent notice in writing from **National Grid** to the **Generator** that the **Suspension** is lifted, no **Availability Fees** shall be payable by **National Grid**, and Sub-Clause 6.2.9 shall have no effect.
- 6.2.14 During any period of **Suspension National Grid** may end the **Suspension** of this Sub-Clause 6.2 by notice in writing to the **Generator**.
- 6.2.15 For the avoidance of doubt, with effect from the lifting of any period of **Suspension** pursuant to Sub-Clause 6.2.14, all accrued or accruing **Events of Default** shall be waived.

### Termination

- 6.2.16 [National Grid may in its absolute discretion terminate the provision of Minimum Output (Option) prior to expiry of this Sub-Clause 6.2 with effect from the end of a Trading Day by giving notice in writing to the Generator by 17.00 two (2) Trading Days prior to that day (for example, a notice given to the Generator at 18.00 on a Wednesday will be effective at 23.00 on the following Monday).
- 6.2.17 If **National Grid** terminates the provision of **Minimum Output (Option)** in accordance with Sub-Clause 6.2.16:
  - (a) during a **Service Period**, it shall pay the **Generator** []% of the **Availability Fee** for each **Settlement Period** during the remainder of that **Service Period**; or
  - (b) during an **Extended Service Period**, it shall pay the **Generator** []% of the **Extended Service Period Availability Fee** for each **Settlement Period** during the remainder of that **Extended Service Period**.]
