



The showers becoming mainly focused across eastern areas where they become heavy and possibly thundery. Western areas will turn drier, but cloud increases later in the afternoon.  Tonight:  Cloud, rain and strengthening winds moving gradually east across many parts, with the heaviest rain across Northern Ireland. Northern Scotland continuing with a mix of clear spells and showers.
