This note sets out the headlines and key decisions of the STC Committee on the 20th March 2007. Full minutes of the meeting will be produced and subsequently approved at the next Committee meeting and will then be published on the website.

1) Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes of the STC Committee meeting held on 20th February 2007 were approved.

2) Proposed Amendment Reports

CA023 (Exchange of Best View Investment Planning Data outside the Boundary of Influence) was proposed by National Grid. The Committee agreed that the TO impact assessments on the proposal will be forwarded to National Grid by 2 April 2007.

The Committee agreed that CA024 (Clarification of Construction Planning Assumption Data Requirements), CA025 (Amendment to STC regarding obligations in Connection Site Specification Submissions), and CA026 (Exchange of Data Amongst Relevant Parties in Schedules 5, 6, 7, 11 and 13), STC Parties are to provide their TO impact assessment on the proposals by the 17 April 2007, of this is not possible an update on when the TO Impact Assessment can be provided by 17 April 2007.

3) STC Procedures

Comments were received from David McMenemy with some proposed changes to the STCP18-4. It was agreed the National Grid would update the STCP18-4 and circulate the revised STCP18-4 to Committee Members for agreement with a view to formally approve STCP18-4 on Friday 23 March 2007.
