

Use the Clone / Delete Baskets button to access the Clone / Delete functions.



### 3.1 Clone / Delete Baskets

The Auction is pre-selected depending on your selection in the Baskets screen.

Select a Target Auction from the list to view its existing Baskets.


Select one or more Basket(s) to either Delete or Clone them.

Use the **Delete Selected Baskets** > button to remove the Baskets from the current Auction.



Select a Target Auction from the list in order to Clone selected Basket(s) to the target Auction.

Use the Clone Selected Baskets > button to submit the clone to the target Auction.



After confirmation and cloning successfully, the screen is rerouted to the target Auction.

### 3.2 Edit Basket:


Select an existing Basket to Edit. Note that the name of the selected Basket appears in the Edit Basket button.

Use the Edit Basket: button to access the Edit Basket functions.




The Auction, Unit and Service Window are pre-selected depending on your selection in the Baskets screen.

After confirmation or deletion, the screen is rerouted to the main Basket screen.


### 3.3 Add New Basket

Use the **<Back** button to return to the main Basket screen without submitting or changing any data. Any changes made will be lost.


After submission and confirmation, the screen is rerouted to the main Basket screen.


