1. <u>Title of Amendment Proposal</u>

Amendments to STCP13-1 regarding provision of interruption payments to NGET.

2. Description of the Proposed Amendment (mandatory field)

The proposed changes have all been discussed and agreed at the Charging User Group ("CHUG") between the SHETL, SPT and NGET.

The changes are summarised below:

- Addition of new section on remuneration by a TO to NGET in relation to interruption payment *Section 1.3.3.*
- Addition of new definition, "NGET Charges" Section 2, "Key Definitions"
- Introduction of a new section for dealing with NGET Charges New section 3.4.

3. Description of Issue or Defect that Proposed Amendment seeks to Address (mandatory field)

If a User is interrupted as a result of an incident in the transmission system then NGET investigates the cause and makes an interruption payment to the User, however until recently, there was no mechanism within the STC for TOs to pay NGET in the event of an interruption on part of the transmission system in Scotland. This STCP amendment enables, where applicable, the payment of consequential interruption payments by the relevant TO to NGET.
