# STC Working Group CA039, (Including PA059, PA060, PA061) Report to STC Committee Meeting – 28<sup>th</sup> September 2010

## Background

- 1. Amendment Proposal CA039 was submitted to the STC Committee for consideration on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2010.
- 2. The STC Committee agreed that CA039 should proceed to the Evaluation Phase in accordance with Section B of the STC and as such a working group should be established.
- 3. The working group was composed of representatives from NGET SHETL and SPT and Terms of Reference were agreed (attached) at the first working group meeting.
- 4. The working group has met twice since the STC Committee meeting that CA039 was submitted to and in accordance with Section B of the STC, the Evaluation Phase ends on

## **Amendment Proposal**

- 5. It is proposed to amend Section C and Section J of the STC to allow for a two year outage plan to be submitted by the Transmission Owners to NGET, of which the second year would consist of MITS outages only.
- 6. The working group has discussed the legal text to effect this proposal and the legal text will form part of the Proposed Amendment Report to be circulated to the industry for consultation at the Assessment and Report Phase.
- 7. The working group has considered which of the STC objectives are better facilitated by this amendment proposal and this will be stated in the Proposed Amendment Report.
- 8. The working group also discussed the associated STC procedural amendments with respect to outage planning development which will affect STCP16-1, STCP11-1 and STCP11-3. Although Amendment Proposals for these STCPs were raised in parallel with CA039, and they were not formally included in the Evaluation Phase for CA039, drafting work has been progressed by the working group to be completed outside this working group.
- 9. Amendments proposed for STCP16-1 and STCP11-1 together will provide for more information exchange between NGET and the Transmission Owners and therefore better outage planning alignment. There will also be a handover meeting between NGET's long term planning department (3-5 years) to medium term planning (1-2 years) which the TOs will be invited to be part of.

10. It should be noted that STCP16-1 cannot be amended until PA048 (concerning STCP16-1) has been completed which is expected imminently.

## Recommendations

11. The working group recommends that the STC Committee agree to move CA039 forward to the Assessment and Report phase and as such prepare a draft Proposed Amendment Report to go out to industry consultation.

# **Evaluation Phase Terms of Reference and Membership of Working Group**

## TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR CA039 WORKING GROUP

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. The working group is responsible for assisting the STC Committee in the evaluation of STC Amendment Proposal CA039, "Amendment of outage planning timescales to enable more coordinated outage planning", submitted by National Grid at the STC Committee on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2010.
- 2. The proposal must be evaluated to consider whether it better facilitates achievement of the Applicable STC Objectives. These can be summarised as follows:
  - (a) efficient discharge of the obligations imposed upon transmission licensees by transmission licenses and the Act;
  - (b) development, maintenance and operation of an efficient, economical and co-ordinated system of electricity transmission;
  - (c) facilitating effective competition in the generation and supply of electricity, and (so far as consistent therewith) facilitating such competition in the distribution of electricity;
  - (d) protection of the security and quality of supply and safe operation of the national electricity transmission system insofar as it related to interactions between transmission licensees; and
  - (e) promotion of good industry practice and efficiency in the implementation and administration of the arrangements described in the STC.

#### SCOPE OF WORK

- 3. The working group must consider the issues raised by the Amendment Proposal and consider if the proposal identified better facilitates achievement of the Applicable STC Objectives.
- 4. The working group must develop and agree changes to the legal text in the STC to effect this proposed amendment.
- 5. The working group will also consider the impact on the relevant STCPs (for which Amendment Proposals PA059, PA060 and PA061 have been raised also at the 27<sup>th</sup> July STC Committee meeting) and develop the associated text to amend the STCPs.
- 6. The working group will agree an implementation timetable for this Amendment Proposal should it be approved by the Authority.

- 7. In accordance with Section B of the STC the Evaluation Phase shall take no longer than two months before the Amendment Proposal proceeds to the Assessment and Report phase.
- 8. The working group is to submit its final report to the STC Committee Secretary by 21<sup>st</sup> September 2010 for circulation to the STC Committee. The conclusions will be presented to the STC Committee on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2010.
