New Modifications

This modification aims to introduce the concept of Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners (CATOs) to the STCPs to enable Onshore Network Competition for the design, build and ownership of Onshore Transmission assets.

CM089/CM091 Emergency and Restoration Code Phase II	Clarify the requirements on STC parties in order to implement the requirements of the EU Emergency and Restoration Code.	Relates to GC0156/GC0148, expected decision date of 30 January 2024.
