





Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: New Year's Day starting showery in the north, though becoming mostly fine with sunny spells and gentle winds. Southern England and Wales turning wet and increasingly windy after a bright and breezy start. Tonight: Clear spells across northern England and Scotland to start but rain further south soon spreading northeastwards. This confined to Scotland by the early hours with further rain affecting the southwest.
